

# Polson Bay Golf Course Phase One Tournament Procedures

May 12, 2020

Tournaments at Polson Bay Golf Course will begin May 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> under the following guidelines:

**OUT OF STATE PARTICIPANTS:** The State of Montana requirement for out of state visitors is a 14 day quarantine within our borders before participating in any tournament activities.

**MASKS:** When situations where social distancing requirements are difficult to maintain, the use of protective masks is strongly recommended.

**GOLF CARTS:** In consultation with the Lake County Health Department we are no longer requiring single rider carts. However, we completely support and will accommodate your decision to ride alone in a golf cart if you desire.

*\*Daily golf cart trail fees will not be charged for all tournament and practice rounds.*

ALL PRACTICE FACILITIES will open for you 30 minutes prior to your tee time. Please plan your arrival time accordingly.

- Please care for your own equipment and do not handle playing partner's equipment during the course of your round of golf.

- Please pass on the post round handshakes and high "5"s.
- Gatherings of more than ten people post round are explicitly forbidden.
